



# Driving Directions Back to Metro-Atlanta

**To Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport:**

**Miles: 330 | Drive Time: 5 hours, 10 minutes**

## Driving Directions Back to Metro-Atlanta:

1. From the entrance to the island at the 3-way stop, take Florida Highway 300 back across the Apalachicola Bay Bridge to get back to the Florida mainland.
  - a. **From "5'O'clock Somewhere"** Start from 1065 East Gulf Beach Drive. From the driveway, turn right and go about 1.8 miles back to Florida Highway 300. Turn right towards the mainland onto Florida Highway 300.
  - b. **From "Almost Heaven"** Start from 1117 West Gulf Beach Drive. From the driveway, turn left and go about 1.8 miles back to Florida Highway 300. Turn left towards the mainland onto Florida Highway 300.
2. Once back on the Florida mainland, proceed to Highway 98 and turn right. Go 3.5 miles and turn left onto Highway 65 North.
3. Go 54 miles through Apalachicola National Forest on Highway 65 North until you see Highway 20 East in Hosford.

**>>> DANGER WATCH FOR DEER CROSSING THIS ROAD!!! <<< (especially if you risk traveling after dark which is not advisable) numerous deer crossings have occurred on Highway 65 and have caused many accidents to unaware travelers.**
4. Turn right onto Highway 20 East. Go 6.6 miles and turn left onto Florida Highway 267 North (also known as the Pat Thomas Parkway) Keep going past I-10 and you will proceed 16 miles into Quincy where you will find Highway 90 / Jefferson St.
5. Turn right onto Highway 90 / Jefferson St. in downtown Quincy. Go 0.8 miles, turn left back onto Florida Highway 267 North / N. Adams St. in downtown Quincy. Stay on Florida Highway 267. After you cross the Georgia State line, the same road changes to Georgia Highway 302.
6. Stay on Georgia Highway 302. This road will merge with Faceville Highway 97 just past Old Faceville Rd.
7. At this merge, proceed 9.9 miles on Faceville Highway 97. You will come to a fork in the road at S. Old Quincy Rd. - take the right fork to remain on Faceville Highway 97. *NOTE: DO NOT FORK LEFT.*
8. Proceed to the intersection of Faceville Highway 97 and the 84/27 connector. Cross over the 84/27 connector bridge. Where sign points to Highway 84 West / 27 North, turn left onto the 84/27 connector on-ramp. *NOTES: Gas up in Bainbridge as you have limited access to a gas station until you get back to the Chevron station at Victory Drive. (a.k.a. Martha Berry Highway)*
9. Stay straight on the 84/27 connector. This road becomes Highway 27/1 outside of Bainbridge. *NOTES: You will pass through the towns of Colquitt, Blakely and Cuthbert as you head back towards the Chevron station at Victory Drive. (A.K.A. Martha Berry Highway). You have 3 ½ hours remaining until you are back to Atlanta Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport from this point.*
10. Proceed on Highway 27/1 until you dead-end into Victory Drive (a.k.a. Martha Berry Highway) The Chevron station will be directly ahead of you as you intersect with Victory Drive (a.k.a. Martha Berry Highway) Turn left onto Victory Drive (a.k.a. Martha Berry Highway) and go West 11.5 miles towards Interstate 185 (I-185) North.
11. Turn right onto the I-185 on-ramp. Proceed on I-185 North, through Columbus, onto LaGrange where you will merge onto I-85 North. Proceed on I-85 North back into Metro-Atlanta.
